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AMISHLAND & LAKES SAFETY STATEMENT

An accident-free weekend of enjoyable cycling is our primary goal. In addition, the impression that we leave with others, particularly motorists, is important to the future of the Amishland and Lakes tour as well as to the acceptance of bicycling by the general public. All riders on Amishland and lakes are expected to adhere to all traffic laws while on public roadways. Because quiet, low-traffic roads are the majority of our route, it is easy to forget that we share the roads with motorists and bicyclists of varying skills, experience, and riding pace. Good judgment, predictable riding, and a "defensive" attitude play a large part in preventing accidents.

- Ride in a straight line as far to the right as possible
- Don't ride more than two abreast and avoid bunching up, especially on hills or at intersections
- Signal your intentions to change lanes, slow down or stop
- Be alert for overtaking cyclists and allow room to pass
- If you are preparing to pass other cyclists, warn them by calling out "On your left (right)"
- When you stop for repairs or to rest, get completely off the roadway

RIDER'S SAFETY PLEDGE

I pledge to ride in a safe, courteous manner. I will obey all applicable traffic law's and accept directions from Amishland and Lakes officials. I acknowledge that my safety, and the safety of others, depends upon me.

RELEASE OF ORGANIZERS & SPONSORS
